The NWT offers a unique and challenging work environment for mature, self-motivated and energetic individuals as aquatic supervisors to manage pools and waterfronts during the summer of 2012 (approx. May to August).

Positions are available in a variety of isolated, predominantly aboriginal communities, ranging in population from 200 to 2000. This is your chance to do something extraordinary this summer! *"You'll never experience anything like it anywhere else."* (supervisor in Aklavik).

Duties include administering/teaching Red Cross and Lifesaving Society programs, lifeguarding, facility maintenance (including start-up and shutdown), program planning and some regional events such as swim meets. A major emphasis will be placed on delivering local aquatic leadership training, educating community residents on safe water practices and the promotion of boat and water safety.

## Closing Date: April 30, 2012

Only those selected for an interview will be contacted. Applicants must be available for the full period of employment.

## Reference Check:

Because these positions involve the supervision of children, please note that a criminal record check may be requested.

## To apply, please forward the following documents:

- A letter of interest, stating the reasons why you would like to work in the NWT and your preference for either the pool or waterfront position.
- A current resume clearly outlining related work experience.
- Copies of all current certifications with expiry dates clearly shown.
- An indication of any re-certifications that you anticipate completing prior to the start of the aquatic season.
- Three letters of reference (two work-related and one character reference).

## Minimum Required Certification:

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor and/or Royal Lifesaving Instructor
- Bronze Cross
- First Aid & CPR
- 18 years of age or older

## Required Experience:

Pool staff must have pool start-up, shutdown and maintenance experience. Waterfront staff must have general recreation programming experience since these facilities may close due to weather conditions.

Assets: Previous supervisor experience and/or experience in a northern setting. Credit will be given for up to three (3) full years of instructing/lifeguarding.



## Compensation:

The NWT Recreation & Parks Association assists NWT communities to secure their aquatic staff. Each community will interview and hire applicants of their choice. Aquatic supervisors work for the community in which they are hired. They are not employees of the NWT Recreation & Parks Association.

Communities will cover transportation costs for travel to and from the community for the purpose of employment as well as provide accommodation for the entire term of employment. Salaries will be negotiable.
