The Lifeguarding Experts

The Lifesaving Society will provide Affiliate Members:

- The **right to offer Lifesaving Society training programs** and present candidates for evaluation.
- **Interest free credit privileges** which allow the ordering of materials and award processing with payment within a 90 day period.
- **Promotional and educational literature**, including test sheets, posters, brochures, camera-ready artwork and program marketing materials. The Lifesaving Society reserves the right to limit supplies as needed to ensure fair distribution.
- The right to use **Instant Awards** or to have the Lifesaving Society office produce awards for program participants on your behalf.
- Ability to access **Lifesaving Society representatives for technical support** throughout the year. Technical support can be used to assist Instructors, Lifeguards and programmers and can be offered in the form of staff training sessions where suitable and deemed acceptable by the Lifesaving Society.
- Access through the Lifesaving Society to information contained in the **Member Management Database**.
- Various Lifesaving Society communications including **WAVES, seasonal mail-outs, program guides and Drowning Reports** which highlight developments, technical information, resources and issues related to lifesaving and aquatic risk management.
- **Affiliate program advertising support** as available through WAVES, the Newfoundland Labrador web site and via the Lifesaving Society office in response to telephone queries.
- **Promotion and advertising of job postings** as available through Royal Link, scheduled Affiliate mail-outs and the Branch office.
- Ability to request materials from a **resource library** that specializes in aquatics. Loan out time is limited to 30 days.
- **Consulting advice for Aquatic supply purchases** where possible.
- **Advanced notification of new programs** being developed by the Lifesaving Society.
- **One Affiliate Member vote** at the Annual General Meeting of the Lifesaving Society.
- **One Affiliate Member seat** at the Annual Awards Dinner and AGM

Affiliate Members will:

- Abide by all program rules, restrictions and guidelines as set out in writing by the Lifesaving Society.
- Only use Lifesaving Society certified Instructors/Examiners to teach and evaluate Lifesaving Society programs. **
- Be responsible for all Lifesaving Society programs and examinations run in their facilities.
- Positively promote the Lifesaving Society, its mission and its programs to Affiliate customers and public.
- Follow all course registration and merchandise ordering procedures established in writing by the Lifesaving Society.
- Acknowledge the Lifesaving Society's ownership over all of its programs when promoting Society programs in program guides, brochures, fliers etc. The Lifesaving Society's name is to be used when promoting Lifesaving Society programs. The Lifesaving Society's full visual identity, including logo and tag line, is to be used at least once in all promotional materials. Camera ready copies can be obtained from the Lifesaving Society upon request.
- Ensure prompt payment of all Lifesaving Society invoices. Delays in payment of more than 90 days will result in suspension of interest free invoicing privileges.
- Aggressively protect the integrity of the Lifesaving Society's programs as they are delivered at Affiliate facilities.
- Notify the Lifesaving Society of any administrative or program challenges identified.

The parties' non-compliance with the Affiliate Agreement will result in an overall assessment of Affiliate status. In cases where the Lifesaving Society feels that its program, representatives or integrity are at risk, it reserves the right to remove the Affiliate's authority to offer Lifesaving Society programs.
