



Cody Dunne selected to speak at WCDP 2019


Cody Dunne of St. John's will share his drowning prevention research as a speaker at the 2019 World Conference on Drowning Prevention in Durban, South Africa this fall.

"I'm excited to participate in my second WCDP as both a research presenter and participant. Durban is a city I never dreamt I'd have the opportunity to travel to," remarked Cody about his selection as a Speaker Presenter. "When doing research, you're never sure if the project or results are going to be helpful to others. By being selected, I have the opportunity to share more details of what I've been working on and it's an encouraging step."

Cody, who graduates in May from the Doctor of Medicine program at Memorial University, participated as a Poster Presenter at the 2017 World Conference on Drowning Prevention in Vancouver.
